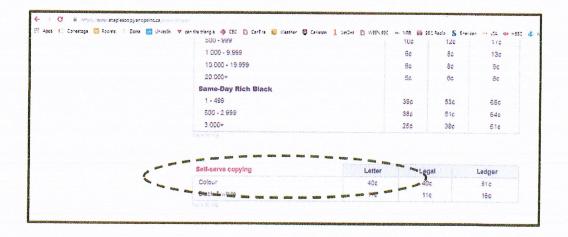

According to the Candidates' Guide, I need to determine the current market value and declare that.

"If you have inventory such as signs left over from a previous campaign and you use them again, the current market value of the signs (i.e. what it would cost you to but those signs today) is considered to be a contribution that you make to the campaign."

1) **Value of Cotour Copies** = \$0.40 + 13%tax = \$0.45 per page



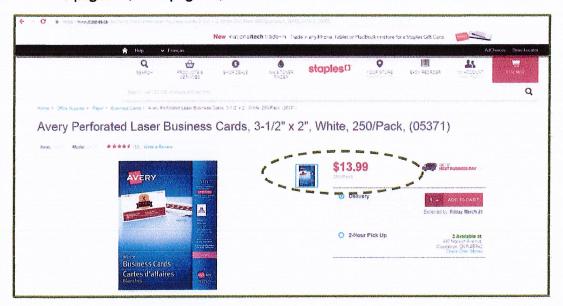
